Travel Declaration for Mid-Year Holidays

If your child/ward did not travel during the holidays, no action is required.

Student Well-Being

To ensure that our school remains a conducive and safe learning environment, we would like to seek your kind cooperation to keep your child at home if he/she is unwell. Students who are unwell should be resting at home for the duration of their medical or hospitalisation leave to allow them to recovery fully. This will help reduce the risk of infecting others.

Should your child be absent for the day, we appreciate that you inform your child's form teacher or call the General Office at 64456483 in the morning of the day of absence. Please submit the medical certificate to your child's form teacher when your child is well enough to return to school.

We also seek your support in ensuring that you child/ward brings along a working Oral Digital Thermometer to school as part of our periodic temperature taking exercise.



3. School Emergency Drills

As part of the School Safety and Security awareness, the school will be carrying the Lockdown Drill Familiarisation Exercise on Thursday, 27 June 2024. This exercise will allow our students and staff to better understand the appropriate measures and actions to be taken in the event of an emergency.

4. Hot and Humid Weather Conditions

Given the hot and humid weather conditions experienced over the past few months, we strongly encourage all students to bring a water bottle to school daily and hydrate regularly. Staying well-hydrated is crucial for maintaining focus and energy levels during these warm days. Students will be permitted to wear P.E. attire to school daily until further notice.

5. Timetable - Semester 2

Due to staff movement, there will be some changes to students' timetable for affected classes. Students of these classes will receive their timetable on **Monday**, **24 June 2024**. The new timetable will take effect from **Tuesday**, **25 June 2024**.

6. Start-it-Right Programme

To help our students get ready for the new school term, all students will undergo a Startit-Right programme for 1.5 days. This is to support our students' transition back to learning in school after the mid-year holidays. Our teachers will spend time to check on the well-being of each student and conduct class discussions on the importance of establishing routines to ensure their well-being, manage time and identify locus of control and to manage expectations and increasing demands. There will also be class-bonding activities for Primary 1 to 4 students to further strengthen the peer relationships in class. We hope that our students come to school ready to learn something new every day and build on the knowledge they have acquired.

7. Holistic Assessment Plan – Semester 2

The Holistic Assessment (HA) Plan for Semester 2 will be issued in Term 3/Week 2. Parents can refer to the HA plan for detailed information on assessment matters.

8. Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE)

PSLE Oral Examination will be held on <u>Tuesday and Wednesday,13 & 14 August 2024</u>. Primary 1 to 5 students need not attend school on these two days. Primary 6 students will receive further instructions on their reporting time for the examination.

PSLE Listening Comprehension will be held on <u>Friday, 13 September 2024</u>. Primary 1 to 5 students need not attend school on this day. Primary 6 students will receive further instructions on their reporting time for the examination.

The PSLE Written Examination will be conducted <u>from Thursday to Wednesday, 26</u> <u>September to 2 October 2024</u>. More information will be provided to Primary 6 students and parents nearer the dates. Here's wishing our class of 2024 all the best in the examination!



9. Primary 6 Preliminary Oral Examination and Written Examination

Students in Primary 6 will take their Preliminary Oral Examination on **Monday and Tuesday**, **22 and 23 July 2024**. The oral examination will be conducted after curriculum hours. As such, parents and guardians will need to make the necessary transport arrangements for your children/wards after the examination. Please note that school bus service does not extend beyond the usual dismissal hours.

The Preliminary Written Examination will take place from **Thursday**, **15 August 2024 to Wednesday**, **21 August 2024**.

10. Primary 6 Direct School Admission Exercise (DSA) 2024

The Direct School Admission Exercise (DSA) 2024 has closed. The secondary schools have diverse selection processes. If shortlisted, your child will have to attend interviews, auditions or trials conducted by the DSA schools. Selected students will receive DSA-Sec offers directly from schools by **Monday**, **9 September 2024**.

11. Primary 6 Supplementary Class and Primary 3 to 5 Remedial Class

To ensure every child receives proper vision care, Damai Primary School will be partnering the Health Promotion Board to bring the Roving Optical Shop to our school on Tuesday, 20 August 2024. MOE FAS students who are required to put on spectacles will be able to receive a pair of spectacles frame with fully subsidised lenses of the right prescription, which will help them to correct their myopia.
